Issue: In the Matter of Approving the Klamath County Sheriff to sign a Memorandum of Understanding between the Klamath County Sheriff's Office-Corrections and Lake County Community Justice.

Background: Klamath County Corrections will lease 730 jail bed days to Lake County Community Justice for housing inmates for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022. The agreement addresses the type and frequency of jail bed usage in accordance to Senate Bill 1145, medical expense mitigation, billing procedures, liability concerns and termination options.

Fiscal Impact: The memorandum of understanding will provide for \$61,000 in revenue to the Klamath County Corrections department of the Sheriff's Office which had been planned for in the 2021-2022 budget year.

Recommended Motion: Approve the Sheriff to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Understanding between Klamath County Sheriff's Office-Corrections and Lake County Community Justice whereby Lake County will pay \$61,000 to Klamath County Corrections for the leasing of 730 jail bed days during the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Lake County Community Justice and
Klamath County Sheriff's Office

This agreement between Lake County Community Justice and the Klamath County Sheriff's Office outlines Community Justice's lease of **Senate Bill 1145 (Jail Beds)** for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

Klamath County Sheriff's Office will be reimbursed a total of \$61,000 by Lake County Community Corrections for lease of 730 jail bed days for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021. Maximum number of beds that can be used at one time is three (3).

The Director of Lake County Community Justice and/or his designee and the Jail Commander of the Klamath County Jail will meet as needed to manage the bed days and to address any issues that arise, including medical issues. The parties agree that \$100 per month, per inmate, to be a fair representation of medical expenses in the bed day rate. Any medical issues that require expenses in excess of that amount will result in a request to mitigate the issue between the parties immediately. If the issue cannot be resolved, the parties agree to find an alternative housing arrangement for the impacted inmate.

The agreement is intended to cover male inmates for a majority of the bed days. On a case by case basis and with prior approval from the Klamath County Jail Commander, the parties may agree to house female and special housing inmates pursuant to this agreement.

Billing for this agreement may be done in advance of each agreed upon billing cycle, up to quarterly payments, or annually. Billings shall be submitted to Lake County Community Justice and will be paid on Lake County's accounts payable schedule.

This agreement is in effect under the following conditions:

The provisions of this memorandum of understanding are contingent upon the appropriation of funds by the State and County. If funds are not appropriated or any of the appropriations are subsequently amended by any part, any and all provisions of the agreement thereupon become voidable at the option of the County, or subject to amendment.

Termination of this agreement must be in writing, giving the other party, at a minimum, 30 days' notice.
