Michelle Ayers addresses the Board regarding the offer made by Robert Gordon on Eternal Hills. She said, the offer is to buy it for \$175,000 and donate the cemetery portion to the County. She said, he is not legally able to own a cemetery. Commissioner Boyd said, actually owning a cemetery is a liability, it is for everyone, even for the County and he feels he made the offer because he just wants the profit side of the business. Ms. Ayers asked about Mr. Gordon needing to rezone/move plot lines. Commissioner DeGroot said he's worked with our Property Sales and let the bankruptcy trustee know that the County is not interested in Mr. Gordon's offer. He said, we are doing our very best to ensure that doesn't happen, ultimately it's up to the judge. Ms. Ayers said she has friends and family writing letters. Commissioner DeGroot thanked Ms. Ayers for her work on putting the clean-ups together.

Commissioner Morris recesses the meeting at 10:05am and the Board leaves to inspect the Jail and Juvenile facilities.
