3. Proposed County Ordinance: Land Application Of Biosolids

Commissioner Boyd explained the proposed ordinance. Representatives from the City express that ideally we would all want Class A water and said their intent is to get out of the river, they are concerned is with the thermal aspects. They offered to look at running the South Suburban Sanitary District (SSSD) water through their processing plant as an alternative. Representatives from the SSSD express their concerns that the ordinance is an attempt by the Commissioners to stop their plan to apply Class C or B water on agricultural ground. Mr. Fritschi said SSSD is willing to work with the City and has been in communication with them. Commissioner Boyd explains this is to protect the citizens and their land. Commissioner DeGroot said, this would apply to any application within the county that meets the standards described within the ordinance. Mr. Fritschi said he appreciates what the County is trying to do to protect the rural atmosphere of the county but there will be a cost to county residents and potentially to city residents as well. Mr. Bellet thanked the Commissioners for calling the meeting. The Commissioners thanked everyone for attending.
