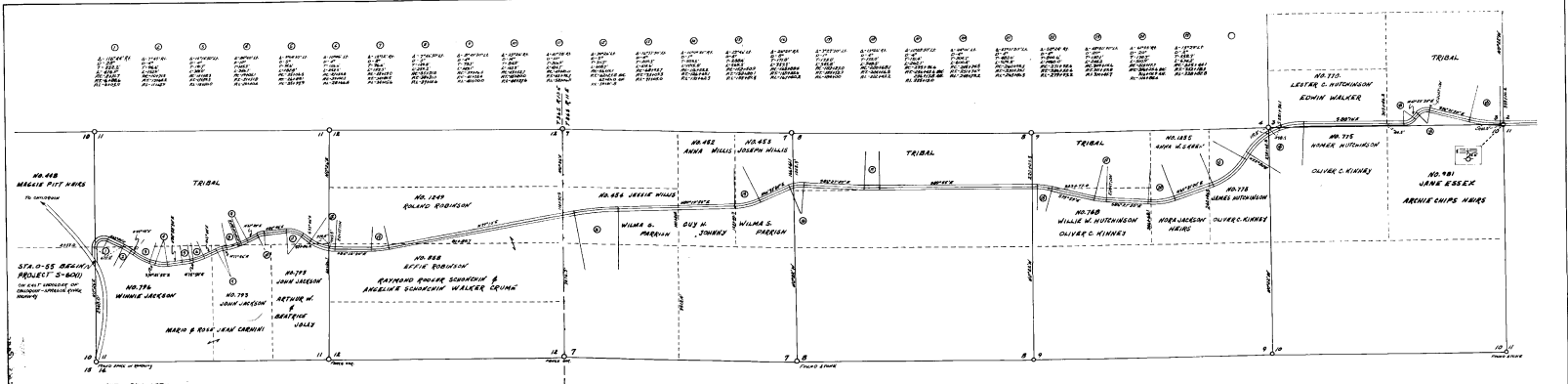

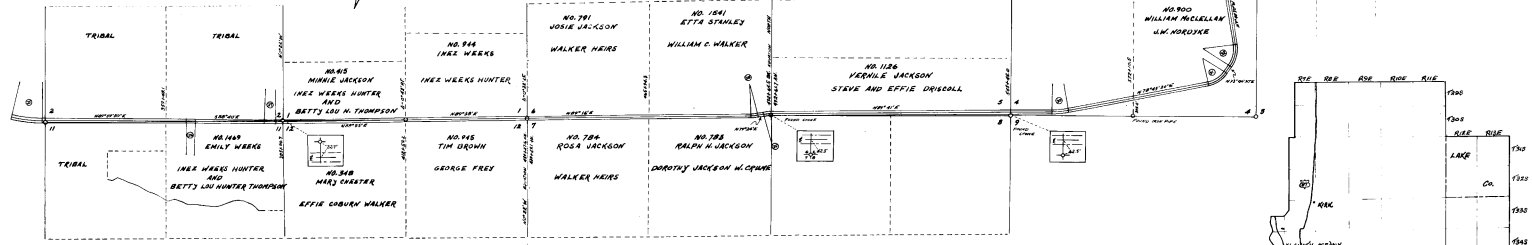


NOTE: OVER WIDTH
