## Klamath County reports 20 new cases of COVID-19, 2 deaths

KLAMATH FALLS, Ore. – Klamath County Public Health (KCPH) officials report 20 new cases of COVID-19, and two deaths. The local case count is 2,505. Deaths now number 46.

This week's total is 76. The reporting week runs from Sunday through Saturday.

The deceased were:

- An 80-year-old woman who died January 19 at her residence. She had underlying health conditions.
- An 80-year-old woman who died January 20 at Sky lakes Medical Center. She had underlying health conditions.

To protect yourself:

- Keep your distance by maintaining six feet of social or physical distancing between yourself and others.
- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, utilizing hand sanitizer when washing facilities are not available.
- Sanitize surfaces that are often touched.
- Avoid gatherings of any size where social or physical distancing is not possible.

To protect others around you:

- Cover coughs and sneezes.
- Stay home when sick.
- Wear a clean mask in public spaces, including outdoors when six feet of social distance cannot be maintained.
