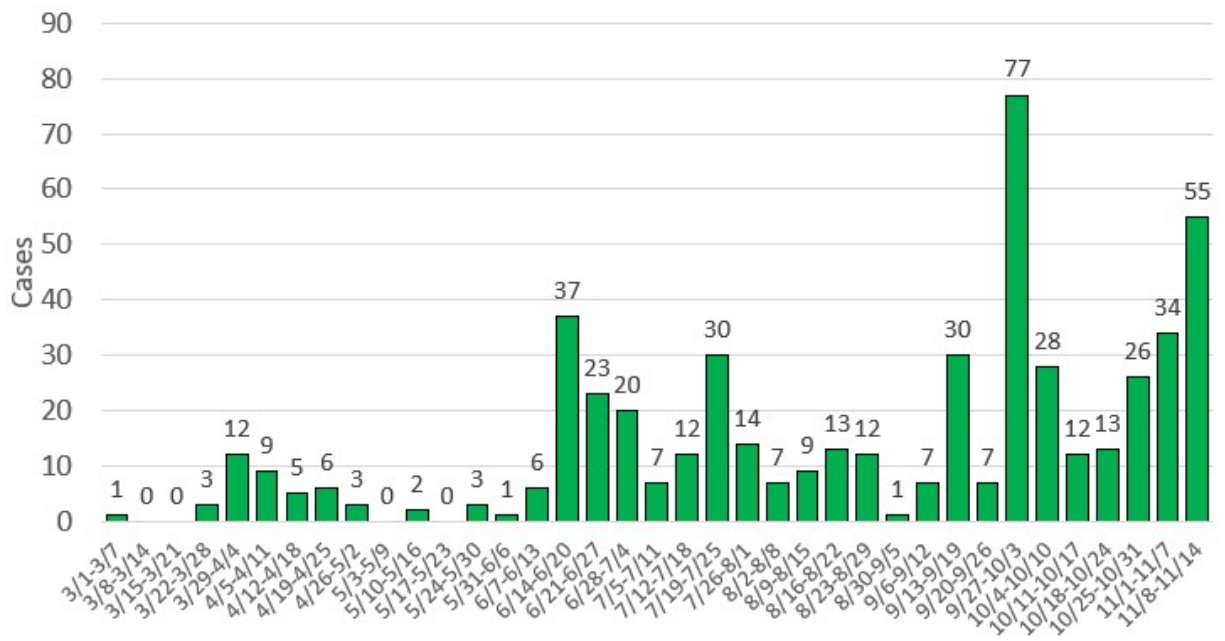

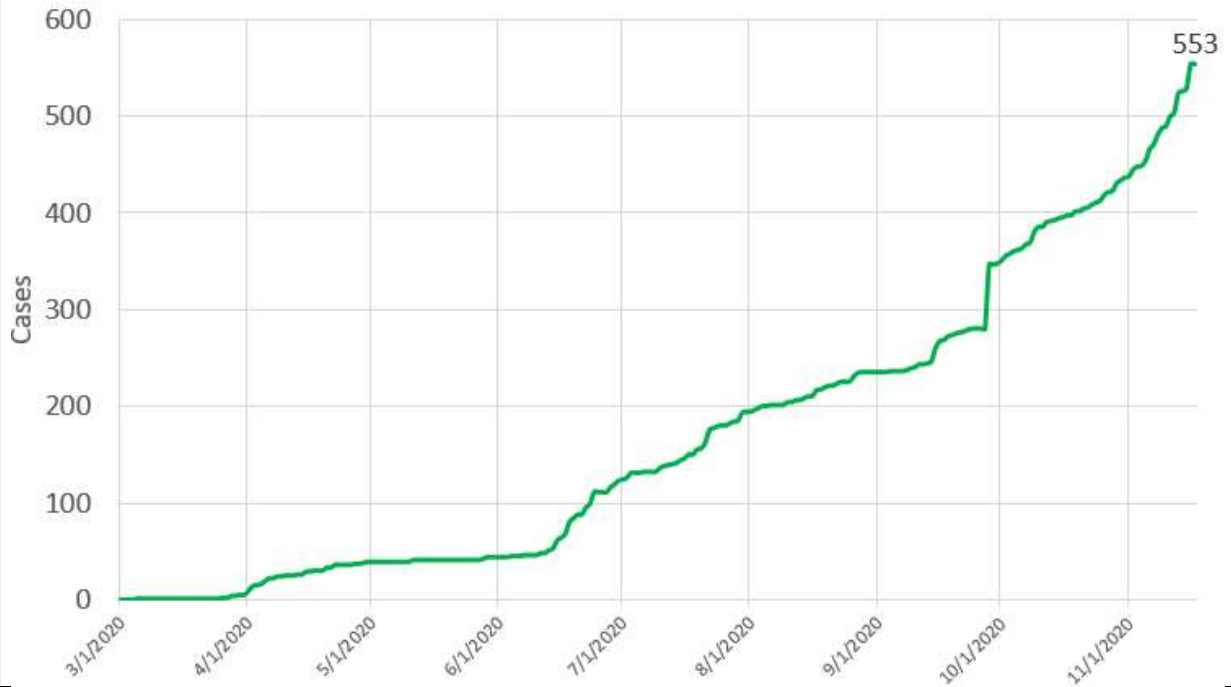

Klamath County Known COVID-19 Cases - Cumulative

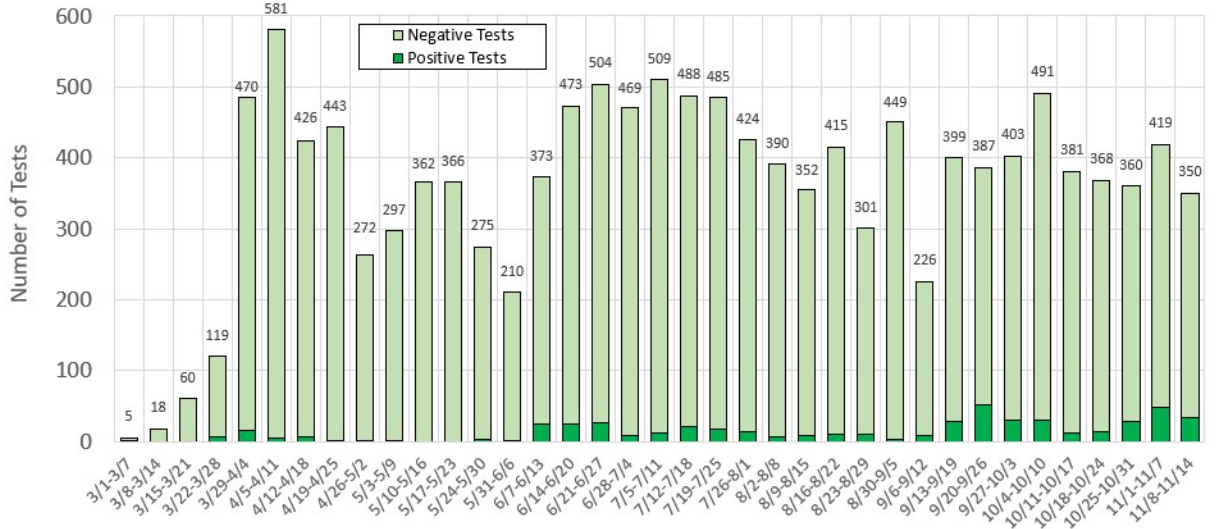

Klamath County Weekly COVID-19 Tests



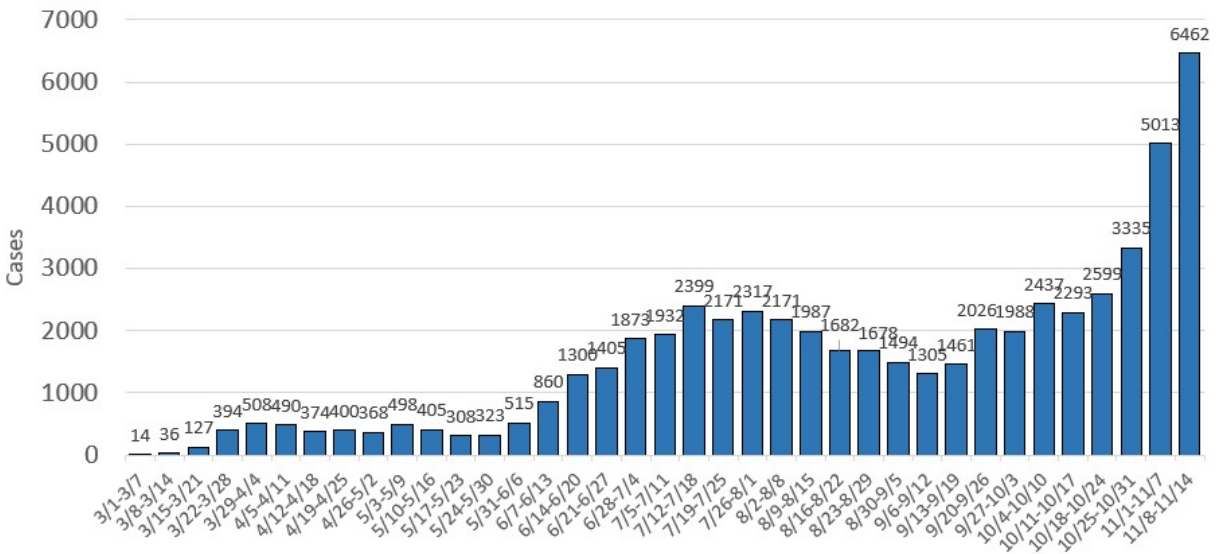

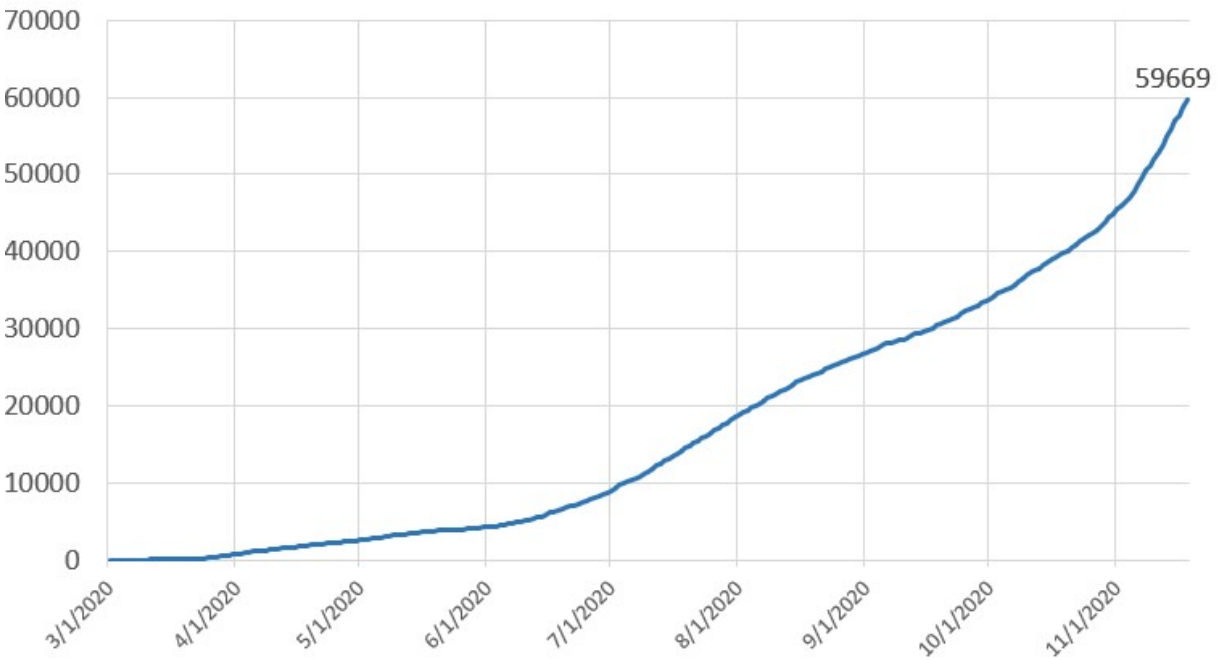

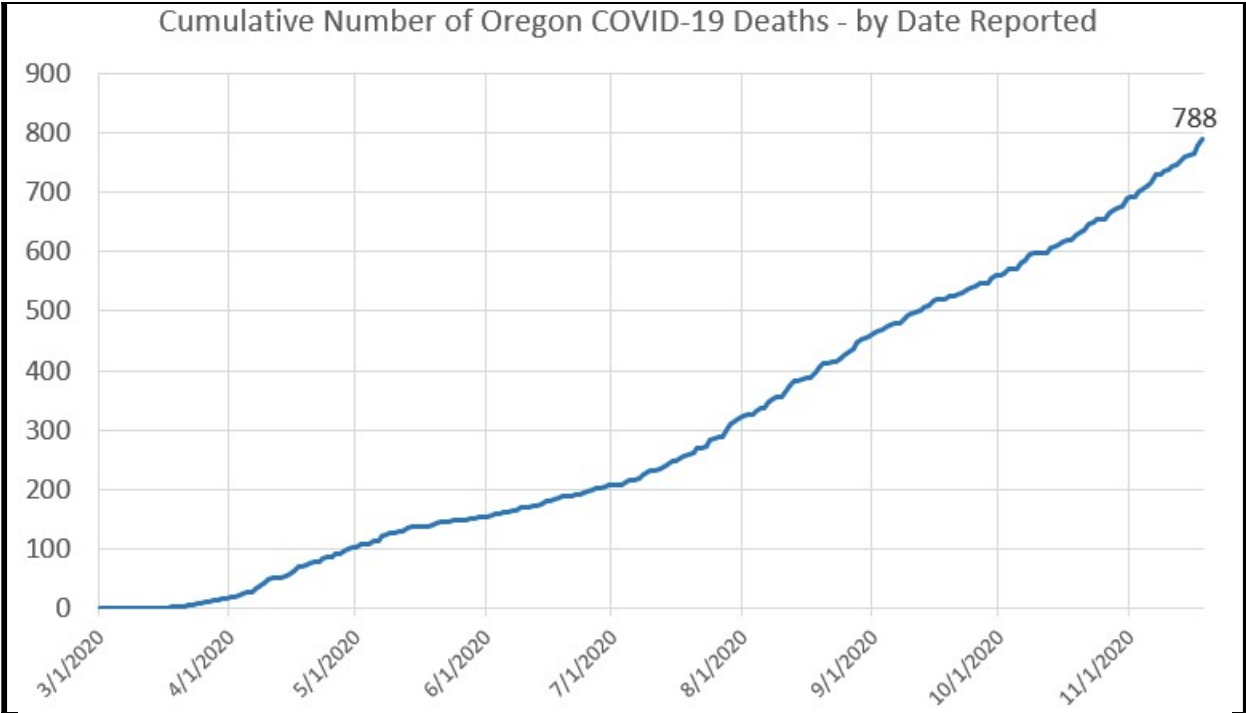
Oregon Known COVID-19 Cases - By Calendar Week

Cumulative Number of Known Oregon COVID-19 Cases - by Date Reported



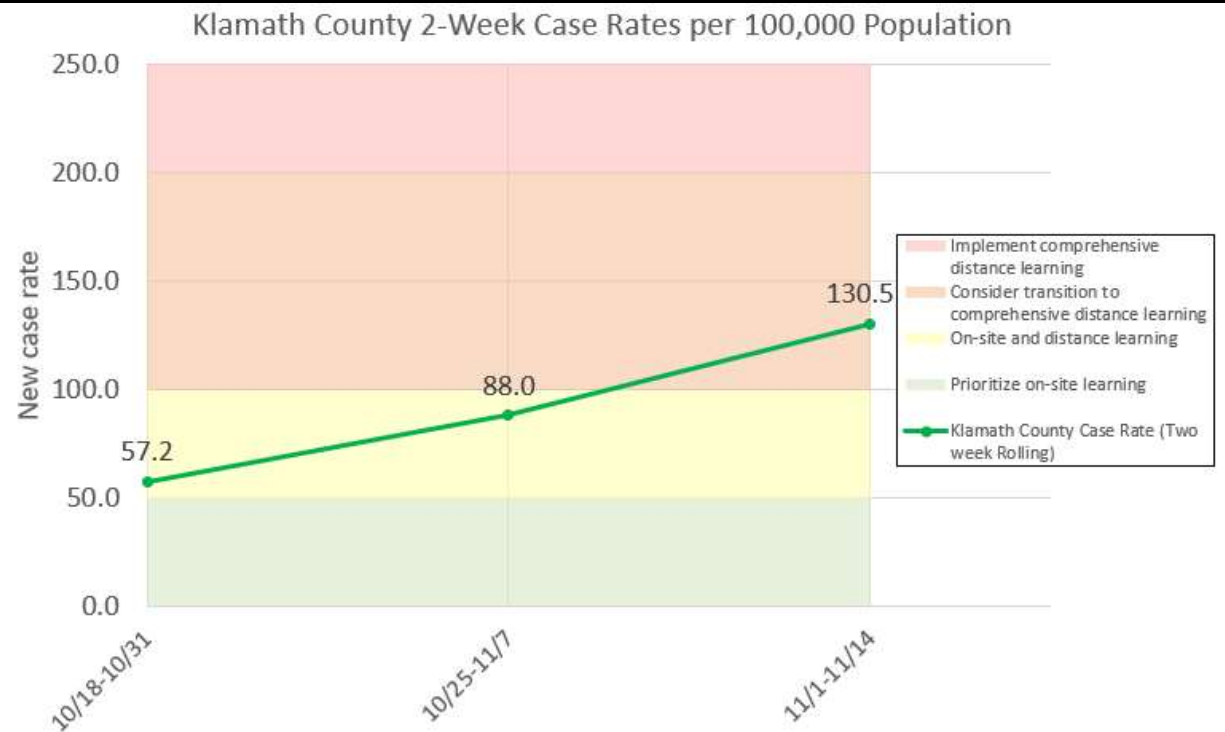

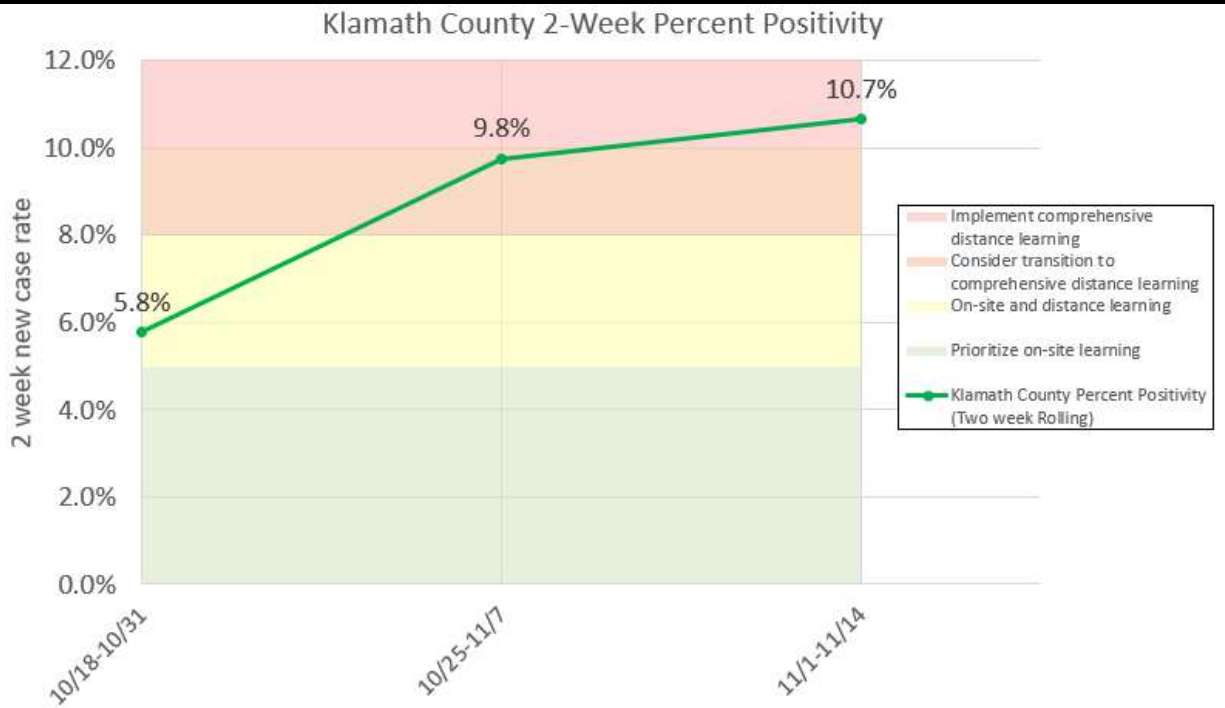
