The Klamath County Animal Control Advisory Task Force will host a free rabies vaccine clinic on Saturday, April 1<sup>st</sup> from 10am-2pm in the Blue Building at the Klamath County Fairgrounds and on Sunday, April 9<sup>th</sup> from 1pm-3pm at the Chemult Fire Hall. The public is invited to bring their canine friend in for a free rabies vaccine. There will also be an opportunity to license your dog as well as discounted pricing on microchips and other vaccines. Klamath County Animal Control will waive late fees associated with licensing to anyone who does not have unpaid fines.

Basin Transit Service has generously donated free bus passes for pet owners and their dogs to ride to the vaccine clinic at the Fairgrounds on April 1. All dogs are required to be in a pet carrier to ride on the bus. Free bus passes can be obtained by calling Animal Control, 541-882-1279.
