Issue: Resolution Declaring an Emergency Exists at the Klamath County Transfer Station located on Tingley Lane.

Background: On May 16, 2021, a major fire occurred at the Klamath County Transfer Station located on Tingley Lane. OAR 137-047-0280 and the Klamath County Contracting Policies and Procedures allow an agency, in its discretion, to enter into public contracts without competitive solicitation if an emergency exists. In order to proceed with the recovery efforts to gain access to the building to determine the structural integrity and to demolish the facility, engineering and demolition services are required as danger to public health and safety now exists.

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2021, a major fire occurred at the Klamath County Transfer Station located on Tingley Lane; and

WHEREAS, OAR 137-047-0280 and the Klamath County Contracting Policies and Procedures allow an agency, in its discretion, to enter into a public contract without competitive solicitation if an emergency exists; and

WHEREAS, in order to proceed with the recovery efforts to gain access to the building to determine the structural integrity and to demolish the facility, engineering and demolition services are required; and

WHEREAS, the County has previously obtained the services of ZCS for engineering services and Bogatay Construction for demolition and construction services; and

WHEREAS, competition will be encouraged to the extent reasonable under the circumstances for future construction and other services related to replacing the building and any required contents.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Klamath County Board of Commissioners:

1. Declares that an emergency exists which necessitates the prompt performance of two contracts, one for engineering services and one for demolition services as outlined above; and

2. OAR 137-047- 0280 and the Klamath County Contracting Policies and Procedures provide for an exemption from the advertising requirements and authorizes the direct solicitation for quotes or proposals from local contractors for the construction phase which must be awarded within sixty days from the date of this Resolution.
