**5. Food Policy Council Update**

Renae Wood addresses the Board. The Food Policy Council hasn't been too active during this time but the community has been doing a ton for food insecurity. The Food Bank has seen a 70% increase in need from last April to this April and they have been able to meet the demand. The school districts are doing a phenomenal job of responding to the need of feeding kids. The pandemic EBT program will be rolling out shortly, families who receive free/reduced lunch will receive an EBT card. Commissioner Boyd asks, is it \$384.00 per month on the card? Ms. Wood said it's a one time amount of \$384.00. It is an amount for the lunches they would have received if school was in session.

Commissioner Morris asks, how do people get the EBT cards? Ms. Wood said it should be automatic, they should get them in the mail or if they are on SNAP currently, it will be loaded on to their SNAP card. Families that weren't previously receiving free/reduced lunches but need the service now will need to apply. The Park and Play program for this summer will follow the theme of the school districts and not have congregate sites. They plan too create activity packets to hand out with the lunches. The Board thanked Ms. Wood for the update.
