Pilot Project for radar activated dynamic speed signs on Harlan Drive

In following up on a tragic accident that occurred last year on Harlan Drive, Klamath County conducted a test with a mobile radar speed sign. Traffic counts conducted with and without the radar signs indicated a noticeable reduction in average speeds through the test section.

We are now planning to install two dynamic speed displays on a section of Harlan Drive near La Marada that will provide drivers feedback about their speed in relationship to the posted speed limit. Speeds will be monitored to determine if there is a long term positive impact on driver compliance with posted speed limits.

Note that this is a pilot project only at this time, and additional installations would be pending long term results of this installation.
