**CERTIFICATE OF KLAMATH COUNTY**

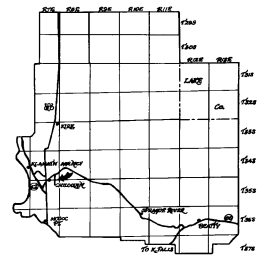
